### **California Part-time Faculty Association**

CCA, CPFA and FACCC cosponsored the December 8, CPFA Winter Workshop at Saddleback College. Over fifty full and part-time faculty from the southern region attended this important meeting.

CCA and CPFA are great allies at the state level, working together to achieve equity for part-time faculty. Both organizations support pro-rata pay and encouraged faculty to support 100% parity.

During the first workshops of the day, Judith Mandel and David Milroy spoke about equity issues, including equal pay, office hours, health insurance, and job security. After all, achieving parity without also achieving job security is a rather empty victory.

The second workshop focused on legislation geared to part-time faculty rights and benefits. Morning speakers included Doug Lindsey, Legislative Advocate for FACCC and Rachel Maldonado Aziminia, CCA Vice President .

Rachel announced CCA's proposed legislation to address the 60% law and its effect on our campuses such as work during inter-sessions, participation in committees and involvement in grants. There was vigorous discussion of the proposed legislation with much needed input from those affected by it.

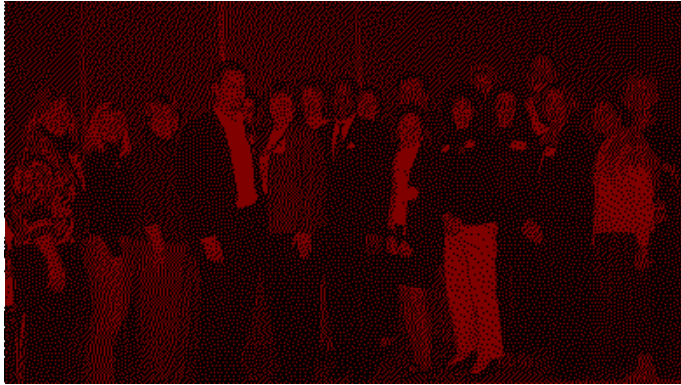
